

Schedule for **Workshop on Teloschistales: Towards a unified and phylogenetically based classification**
Kristiansminde, Denmark [11-14 May 2012]

11th May 2012

9am-1pm: Participants' arrival at Copenhagen

1pm-2pm: Gathering at University of Copenhagen. Dept. of Biology (see Practical Information document for details).

The excursion includes a short stop on the way to see the world's 'rarest' *Caloplaca* (*alstrupii*). For your information, the north coast has well developed terricolous, *Cladonia* rich communities, but unfortunately hardly any Teloschistaceae, except *X. parietina*.

Arrival at Copenhagen by 2pm.

After that you can visit the herbarium (C), enjoy Copenhagen, or go back home.
